Materials	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. topic note provided by teachers the week prior to presentation; see attachments for Show and Tell topic ideas. 2. Show and Tell items brought in by the students
Activities	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Teachers provide a Show and Tell topic to students on the last day of class. 2. Teachers demonstrate by doing the next week's Show and Tell. 3. Students bring in a Show and Tell item that corresponds to the topic of the week and talk in front of the class to tell about their object. 4. Students in the class have an opportunity to ask questions or share ideas, comments, etc. 5. Approximately 10 - 15 minutes per day is dedicated to Show and Tell. Participation is optional.

Reflection	<p>The class atmosphere is positive during Show and Tell. Everyone is interested in seeing and hearing what their classmates bring in to share. In a multi-level classroom with 2 classes run simultaneously in one room, Show and Tell has helped to bridge the gap between the "levels." Students are more willing to move between the two sections of the classroom because everyone is comfortable with each other and with the teachers.</p>

Show and Tell -- Week of October 13, 14, 15

TOPIC: something from your country -or- something about your country.

Show and Tell -- Week of October 20, 21, 22

TOPIC: a **TOOL** you use for your job – the work you do .

Be ready to **SHOW** us this item and to **TELL** us (in English!) all about it!

Show and Tell -- Week of November 3, 4, 5

TOPIC: something about the month of **NOVEMBER**

Be ready to **SHOW** us this item and to **TELL** us (in English!) all about it!

Show and Tell -- Week of November 10, 11, 12

TOPIC: Bring something hidden in a paper bag.
Tell the class 3 clues that describe what it is.
Show us the hidden item after we try to guess it!

Show and Tell -- Week of January 12, 13, 14

TOPIC: bring in a picture of your favorite animal.

SHOW us the picture
TELL us about the animal
