Activities	 Write the question" Why is 4th of July a holiday?' Teacher writes student responses on board. Encourage students to share information about a similar holiday from their native country. Look up the meaning of the word revolution and independence on the internet or English dictionary. Practice pronunciation of revolutionary war vocabulary from citizenship flash cards. Work in pairs to ask and answer citizenship flashcard questions. Follow-up: Bring information to share with class about 4th of July celebration; pictures or journal writing about picnics, fireworks, cook-outs, parades etc.
Assessment/ Evidence	Discussion participation evidence of the level of listening and speaking skills.

	Citizenship question and answer activity showed listening, speaking and reading skills. Worksheet activity showed the level of comprehension of historical facts.
Reflection	Discussion helped students to open up. They were very excited to talk about a similar holiday from home country. Both open discussion and question answer sessions seems to enhance the listening and speaking skills .Follow up activity showed improvement in level of speaking and writing skills.
