Assessment/ Evidence	One-on-one interview with the student. Select 5-10 community locations that were practiced. Using the Worksheet #1 questions, ask "Where can I buy?" Where can I?"			
Reflection	This lesson is designed to build and practice the vocabulary of town/community places and services. It defines the vocabulary and gives 2 opportunities to use/manipulate the words. Teacher can pre-select the words, or, at a higher level, the group generates the words and share knowledge.


