Civics Objective	 5. Community Resources – Directory Identify, locate, and map important places in the community and list services available and/or importance of each location. Teaching students to sign up for School Closing Alerts via cell phone and/or email.
Time Frame to Complete Lesson	2 hours

Materials	 Handouts: Computer Terms 1 – Directions for setup. 2- from Columbus TV Station ABC-6 website, photos of each step; Internet access, students'cell phones. Check your local stations for School Closing Text/Email Alerts. We used: www.abc6onyourside.com. Students can also setup email notification using Handout-1 Directions for setup
Activities	 Background: We have access to five computers in the classroom, a projector + a separate computer for the teacher. Handout-2 can also be used as a transparency for an overhead projector. <u>At computers</u>: Students work in pairs, pairing a higher level student with a lower level student, in case one student has a lower computer literacy level. <u>1. Read: Handout-1</u>, read and discuss basic computer terms, clarify meanings of new words. Students practice using the mouse to feel comfortable moving the mouse pointer or arrow around the screen, and picking up the mouse and placing the cursor at different locations on the screen, and to

	 see "blinking" action of cursor. Have students practice "left click" (one time, and "double click" and "right click", noting that "left click" is used most of the time. 2. For cell phone alerts only- Students read the "terms and conditions" paragraph before starting. Ask comprehension questions of students to make sure they understand – What kind of cell phone do you have? Do you have unlimited texting or do you have pay each time?
	 3. Students follow the directions to get onto their local TV station website and for setup. Note: Local TV station websites will vary, yet to setup email and/or cell alerts, the information is usually listed under WEATHER or SCHOOL CLOSING categories. 4. Handout-2 is a photo display of each step, lifted from the website we used.
Assessment/ Evidence	Student oral responses.
Reflection	Students enjoyed working on the computer and becoming more comfortable with the keyboard, typing (using backspace or arrow keys a lot because of typing errors) and the mouse. Higher students worked with lower level students well.

Computer Terms:

Mouse: A hand-held device, next to your keyboard, with two buttons ("left click" is used the most). It also moves the "cursor". The cord (wire) stays at the top.

Mouse pointer: A small white arrow that moves on the computer screen. The *mouse* moves the "arrow".

Cursor: A blinking straight line that shows where text will begin. The *mouse* moves the *cursor*.

Keyboard: a set of keys with letters of the alphabet, numbers, arrow keys and other special keys.

HANDOUT 1

To Begin:

1. "click" the START button (bottom left), then "click" on Internet Explorer (blue "e")

2. Do a **GOOGLE** search for the website for your local TV station (Teacher note: You can provide students with the exact website to type in.) Click on <u>WEATHER</u> or <u>SCHOOL CLOSINGS</u>.

Examples: NEWS WEATHER or ABC6-Columbus

- 3. Find **WEATHER**, double click to get onto local TV station website.
- 4. Use your cursor, move across the categories

HOME, NEWS, WEATHER.....
