Elicit from the students what information they need in order to go to the Emergency Room. Show the students the hospital medical forms. Make a list of the key words/information on the form Define the terms in English and native language. Develop a personalized packet of essential documentation and medical information: medical history and insurance information. Teacher can interview students about content of personal

Evidence	Student filled-out wallet medical history form. Interview the student about the information on the form.
