Knowledge Ratings

Purpose:

Use as a pre-reading activity to discover how much is known about a topic and what areas need more information. The completed ratings can be used to inform instruction or to direct student reading and research.

Procedure:

Provide students with a list of words and have them rate how well they know the words using a survey format like one of the ones that follows:
